








### Step 2 - Select Alumni


This will pull up a list of all the people who've graduated from your University





## Step 3 - Filter by location


Enter your desired work location under "Where they live"

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




### Step 6 - Check where they work

By going through their profiles, you can find out which companies have hired people who are similar to you

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## Step 7 - Request informational chats

It doesn't matter whether these companies are hiring right now or not

We'll be reaching out to our university alumni for informational chats

The purpose is to know more about the company, the role, and establish likability and trust with them





There are 2 reasons why this works:

- 1) Shows you are proactive and helps you land referrals
- 2) Even if you don't land a referral, you'll gain insider knowledge that 99% candidates don't have

It's an unfair advantage

This knowledge will take your resume, cover letter, and interviewing skills to another level.
